Founded in 2008, Project 2049 led the charge in Washington, D.C., to shed light on the growing threat from China. The institute has succeeded in that mission. A new challenge – to win the competition – requires an updated approach.

Our Mission

IIPS's mission is to be at the leading edge of strategy and policy development for how the U.S. must compete, **and win**, a global competition with China centered on the Indo-Pacific. The core pillars that guide our efforts are:

1. Safeguard against authoritarian attempts to undermine the American way of life and threaten global peace and stability.
2. Expose the Chinese Communist Party's ambitions and tactics to undermine the global order.
3. Strengthen America's alliances and partnerships in the Indo-Pacific.
4. Promote new global economic and security power centers to counter Beijing.
5. Prepare for conventional and emerging threats across the security, economic, and technological domains.
6. Promote a renewed U.S.-led order anchored in respect for sovereignty and territorial integrity, a preference for the peaceful resolution of disputes, and the embrace of universal human rights.
